The specialist in time switches, temperature- and light control Grässlin GmbH has launched a new generation of innovative and design oriented chronothermostats with its newest product feeling / feeling rf. The digital weekly chronothermostat convinces with modern design in three different colors and meets the newest technical market standards. Individual programming makes the product extremely flexible to particular needs. A large LCD display provides clear information and control of every integrated function. Only 8 push buttons manage all functions of the product in an easy way.

To guarantee a maximum of comfort and an easy start-up feeling includes 4 pre-set programs and one program to be defined by the user. Furthermore, to offer more flexibility the pre-set programs can be modified by the user so they are compatible with the daily / weekly individual requirements. It is possible to program a different temperature each 30 minutes as well as a different temperature profile for each week. 48 different time- and temperature programs promise a comfortable environment.

With integrated functions like ECO, Cleaning, Countdown, Party and Holiday, the feeling / feeling rf products are extremely energy efficient and therefore also offer an environmental advantage. For small temperature changes a manual mode is implemented. The automatic summer/winter time changeover will simplify the users' life even more.

feeling is the perfect device for a 2-wired control of heating systems like gas boilers or burners. It can easily replace an old thermostat and will fit exactly into the same space where the old device was installed.

The feeling rf Set (transmitter & receiver) is very versatile. It is ideally suitable for retrofit purposes. While the receiver has to be installed near the boiler/burner, the user can feel

free to install the transmitter wherever he likes to inside his house. A safe and accurate wireless communication between transmitter and receiver is assured by a 868Mhz signal.

For individual applications, the wireless products feeling rf can be combined with different receivers in the Grässlin range like Rec Uno (surface mounting), Rec Tip rf (plug in timer), FM/1 rf (timer modul). The wireless rf communication allows a quick and easy installation.

A battery discharge level monitoring notifies the user when the batteries have to be replaced. As there is a small battery case at the front of the device replacements can easily be handled. All programmed data will be saved during the replacement in EEPROM.

Providing high flexibility, user- friendliness and various intelligent energy-saving-functions the new feeling product range is the perfect solution to match individual requirments. "YOUR SENSES. OUR SOLUTIONS." has taken on a whole new meaning.
